Last Rotary Year, we faced problems when RI rules and regulations changed. Entrance fee was waived by this change and it gave problems to club administration. This Rotary Year, each and every club tackled the problems wisely and thus confusions were under control. There is a famous principle of fluidity and immu-

ability by Matsuo Basho. As you know, Matsuo Basho himself experienced a variety of matters in the journey called "The Narrow Road through the Provinces" and achieved this concept.
